

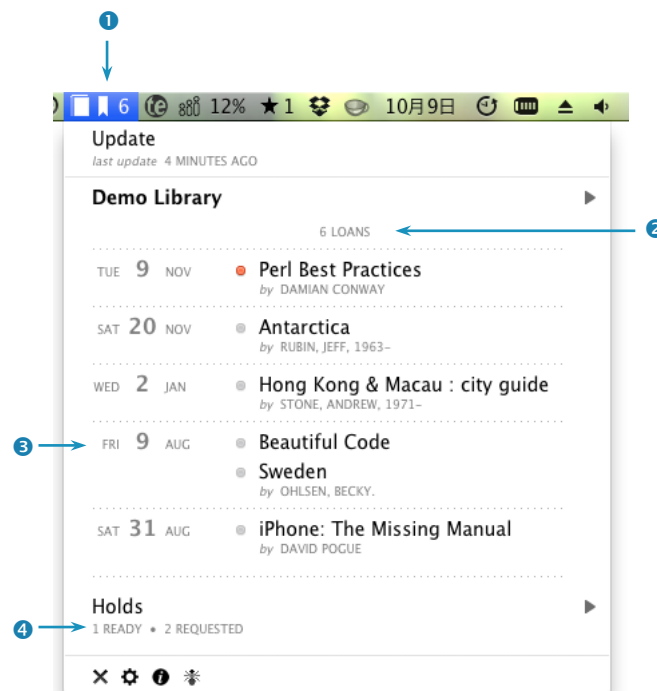
Testing New Library

This document explains how to test a new library that has just been added to Library Books.

1. Download the latest version of Library Books 3 beta from <http://librarybooksapp.com/>.
2. **Note:** your computer needs to be running Mac OS X 10.6. If you have an older version of Mac OS X you will not be able to run Library Books.
3. Run the application.
4. Library Books is a menu application will appear in your menu bar in the top right of your screen.
5. From the Library Books menu click the **Preferences** button:



6. In the **Library Cards** tab and click **Add Library Card**.
7. Enter in your Library Card details.
8. Back in the Library Books menu click **Update**.
9. If Library Books is working correctly you should see the items you have checked out appear in the menu like this:











Checklist:

- Check that the number of loans is correct. 2
- Check that the number of holds is correct. 4
- Check that holds ready for pickup are detected. 4

Notes:

- Items due one the same day will have one due date displayed.
- The menu bar icon will change shape and colour.

10. If you find that none or not all of you loans/holds appear in the menu then send a debug file to Harold Chu for analysis.
11. Click the **Debug** button to save the debug file:
